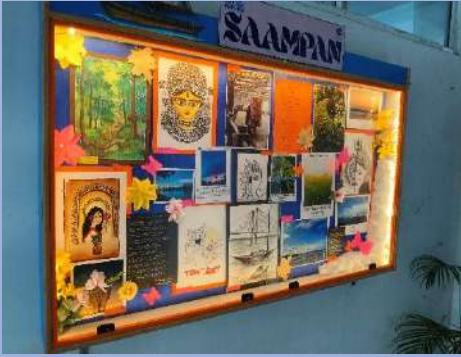
The department proudly unveiled the new edition of *SAAMPAN*, a vibrant and creative display showcasing the artistic talents and literary expressions of the students.
